Our college was founded by Vidya Seva Ratnam Sri. K. Santhanam sir in 1984, with twin objectives: to provide opportunities in higher education to Girls in general and to rural Girls in particular, and to promote the

empowerment of Women through Education, Employment, and economic independence.

As a forty-year-old establishment, our college has already made its mark on the landscape of Indian higher education. The academic year 2024-25 propelled us further, with a renewed focus on education, research, and impact. In alignment with our mission and values, we unilaterally worked toward our goals. Courses Offered
